My Sisters' Place works to end violence in intimate relationships and combat the effects of domestic violence (DV) and human trafficking (HT) on adults and children. As a community-based nonprofit organization located in Westchester County, NY, MSP's mission is to create a world in which every individual has the basic human right to be free from gender-based violence and to engage in relationships that embrace the principles of respect, equality, and safety.

Since our founding in 1976, MSP has taken a holistic approach to addressing the complex intersection of issues encircling DV to effectively respond to the changing needs of families and individuals in crisis, providing a path towards safety and healing, and creating options for rebuilding lives.

MSP's direct services help thousands of individuals each year as they move past the myriad of challenges arising from the experience of DV or HT. Serving clients of all socioeconomic, cultural, and religious backgrounds with multi-lingual and culturally sensitive services to meet their varied needs, MSP provides an accessible, high-quality holistic range of services, designed to address the practical, physical, mental, and social effects of abuse.

OUR SERVICES INCLUDE:

- ✓ A 24-hour crisis hotline for advice and referrals, provided via voice and text/chat
- ✓ An emergency residential shelter and connections to supportive transitional and permanent housing options
- ✓ Individualized case management
- ✓ Comprehensive advocacy to assist families as they navigate the healthcare, child welfare, housing, and justice systems
- ✓ Short-term clinical counseling for families experiencing the psychological and emotional effects of trauma
- ✓ A Center for Legal Services, providing free legal advice and representation in immigration and family law matters
- ✓ Specialized referrals to a network of trusted community partners
- ✓ Support groups for survivors in English and Spanish, that create a space for healing
- ✓ Prevention education and community training programs, which aim to strengthen the overall response to gender-based violence, through schools-based educational workshops for teens, and training for law enforcement, healthcare providers, clergy, and other community members
