Each survivor is unique; each situation is different. MSP responds with:*

## ACCEPTANCE

More than **5,000 callers** reach our 24/7 hotline for help, advice, and information each year. Our multi-lingual advocates respond with understanding and knowledge, providing each caller with guidance on safety planning and meaningful options about the available next steps.

## SUPPORT

MSP provides **2,500 families** annually with a safe place to process the complicated emotions that can arise from domestic violence and human trafficking. Our trauma-informed approach to individualized advocacy and case management, provided alongside evidence-based clinical services, acknowledges that abuse can have lasting effects.

## ENCOURAGEMENT

Steps toward justice take many survivors through family court or the immigration process. With a strong advocate from MSP's Center for Legal Services by their side, **2,300 survivors** a year affirm their rights. MSP attorneys provide expert advice, ongoing safety planning, and a nuanced understanding of how the law may be used against their clients.

## SAFETY

MSP's confidentially located shelter provides support and pathways to independence. We provide **6,400 nights of safety** each year for survivors in immediate danger, serving a critical need for families as they rebuild.

## NURTURING

MSP's supportive programs for the youngest survivors build resilience and promote healing, strengthening parent-child relationships and **breaking the cycle of abuse**. Healthy relationship workshops for teens guide their understanding of consent, boundaries, and how to find help when faced with dating violence or abuse at home.

## CHOICE

As clients set **goals for the future**, MSP connects them to options for stability and self-sufficiency. Our specialized advocates help survivors as they navigate housing and healthcare systems. Financial literacy classes, educational opportunities, and support groups open up possibilities for growth, renewing clients' confidence for the path ahead.
