Accepted Items

- Diapers and pull-ups of all sizes
- Baby wipes
- Feminine hygiene products (*Unopened boxes only. Pads are preferable to tampons.*)
- New, full-size toiletries (*travel size not accepted*), including shampoo, conditioner, bodywash, moisturizer, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, hand sanitizer
- New duffle bags and backpacks
- New twin bed sheets / bed-in-a-bag
- Gift cards: Survivors use donated gift cards to regain independence and to purchase items that they need and the brands that they prefer. Requested gift cards include:
